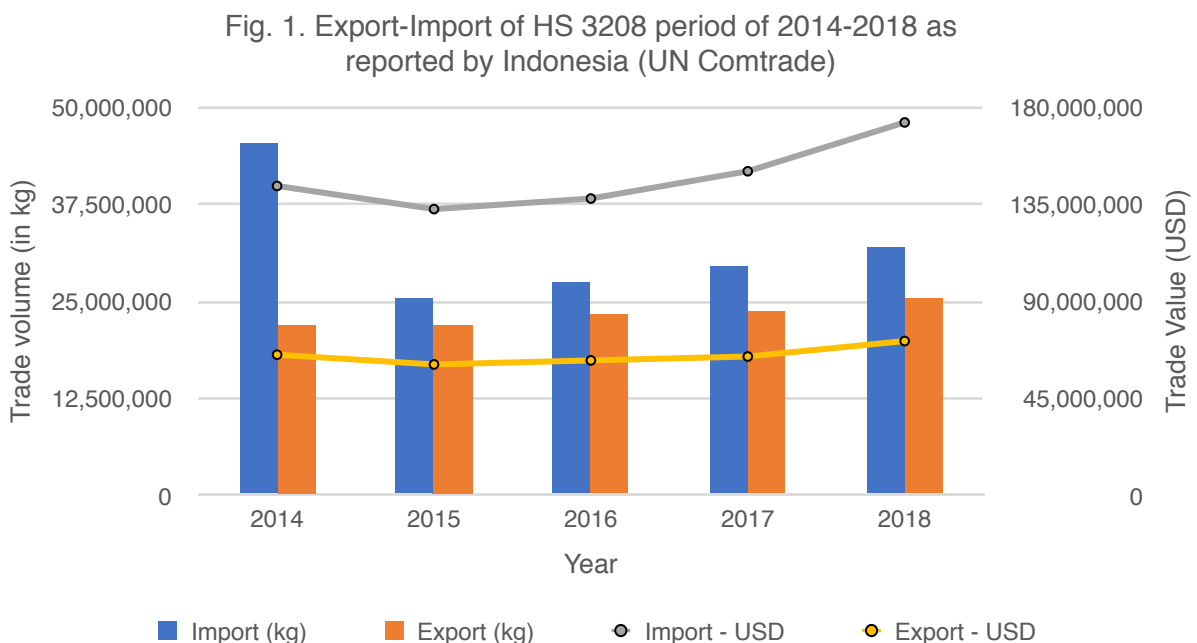
Elimination of Lead in Paint in Indonesia

1. Baseline Information

1.1. Indonesia's paint market

Indonesia holds the first position as the biggest market in paint and coating in South East Asia with the 268 million population and high urbanization rate (57%). Indonesian paint and coating industry growth rate is 6% annually for the past five consecutive years. Paint and coating industry in Indonesia involves six multinational, four domestic, and large numbers of small-scale domestic producers, with the most demand from architectural sector. Domestic producers is attributed to 71% total market in Indonesia. Programs from the government, such as the development of 10 million new housings for middle-low income communities also push the demand for paint and coatings.

Domestic paint production, with around 150 company, annually produces 1,500,000 MT, with the domestic demand of 1,100,000 MT per year, covering 80% domestic markets.¹ Paint and coating [raw materials](#), however, are heavily dependent on imports. Recently, paint industry also [receives incentive](#) from the Indonesian government in a form of tax duty coverage (BMDP/*Bea Masuk Ditanggung Pemerintah*) equal to IDR 10 billion (USD 709,995) to import registered paint manufacturing raw materials in 63 commodities.

Although Indonesia’s paint and coating industry produces 1.5 million metric tonnes annually, Indonesia still imported enamel paints. HS code 3208 is a trade commodity for paints, varnishes, enamels and lacquers, based on synthetic polymers or chemically modified natural polymers; dispersed or dissolved in a non-aqueous medium. In 2014, Indonesia imported about 45,000 metric tonnes of enamel paints and about 22,000 metric tonnes. As the domestic capacity increased over time, in 2018, Indonesia imported approx. 32,000 metric tonnes and exported about 25,000 metric tonnes. Figure 1-5 shows the trade flow of enamel paints, lead-based pigments and driers within the period of 2014-2018.

Fig. 2. Indonesia imported enamel pigments (HS 3212) period of 2014-2018 (UN Comtrade)

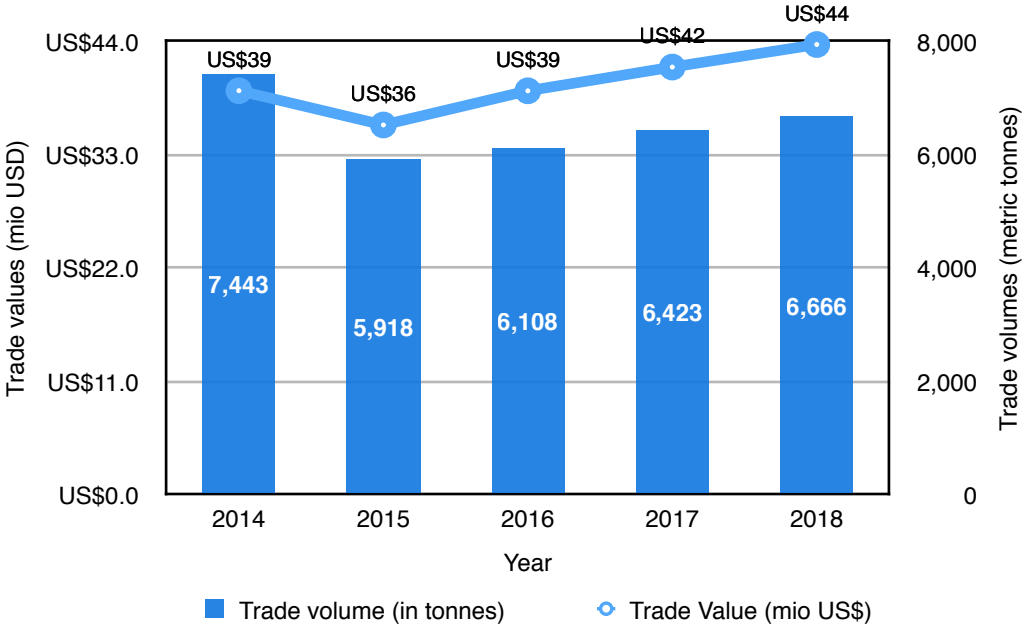


Fig. 3. Indonesia imported inorganic colouring (HS 3206) period of 2014-2018 (UN Comtrade)

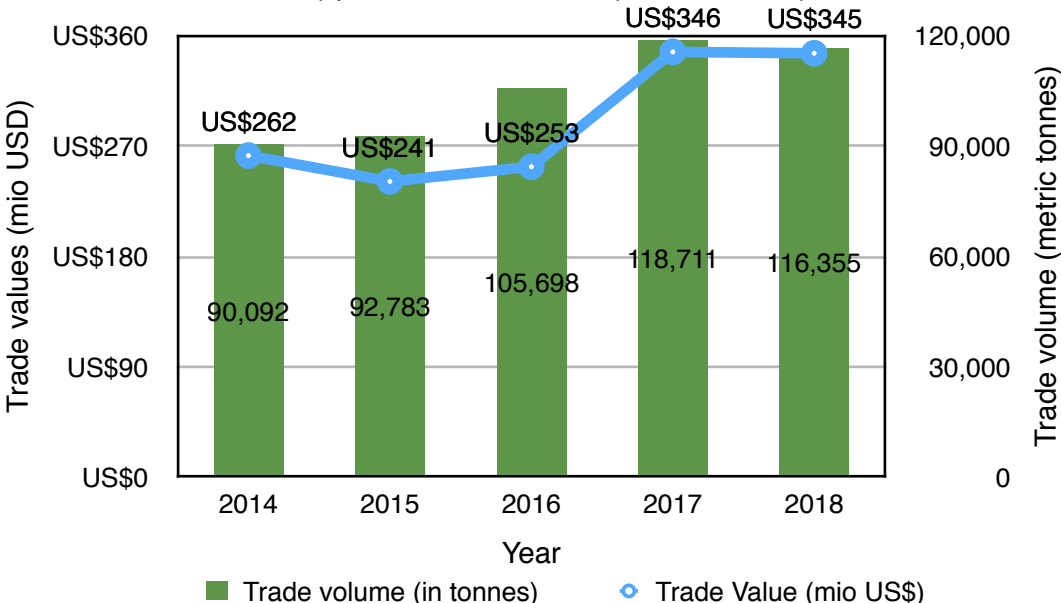


Fig. 4. Indonesia imported prepared driers (HS 3211) period of 2014-2018 (UN Comtrade)

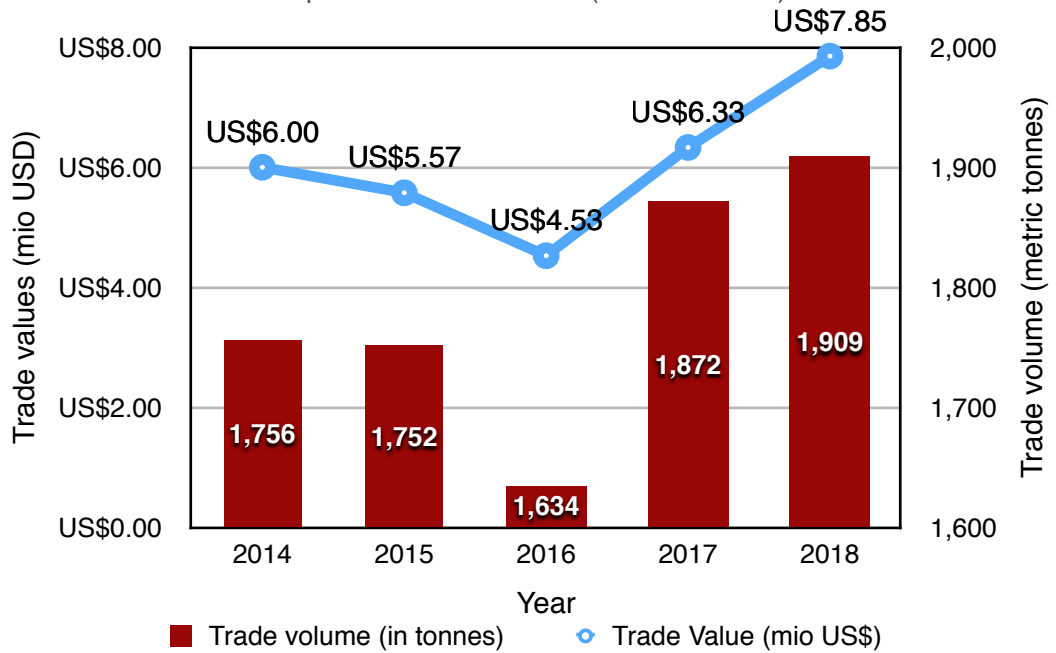
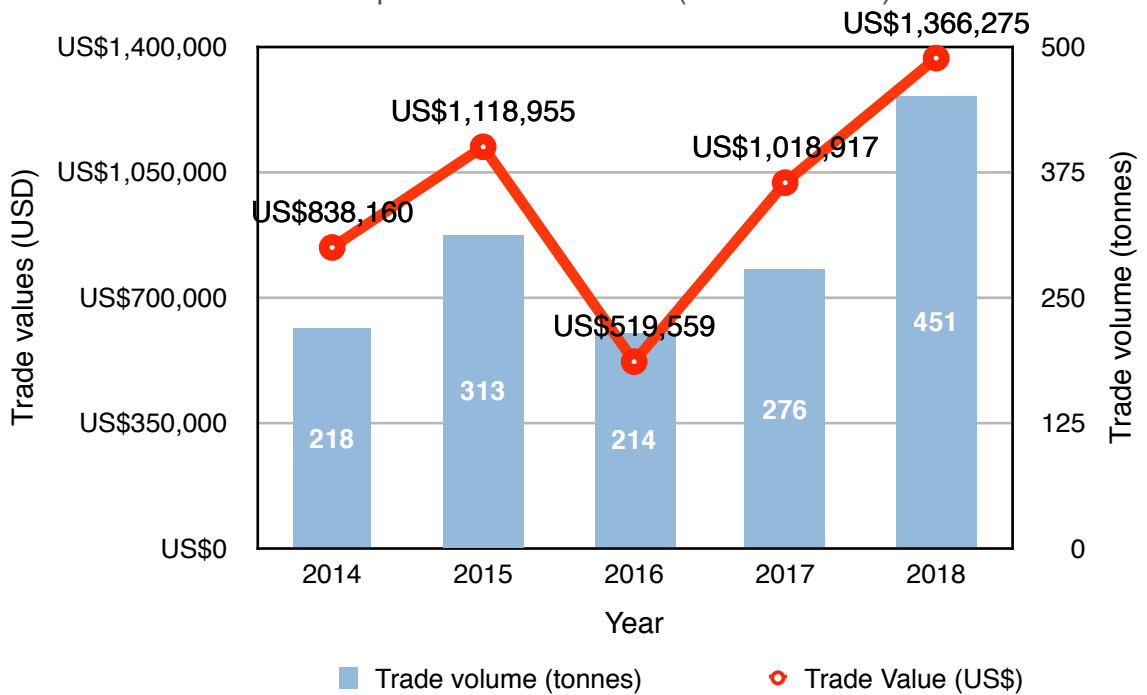


Fig. 5. Indonesia imported lead pigment (HS2824) period of 2014-2018 (UN Comtrade)



1.2. Green industry initiatives

Indonesia has been identified as the 15th global emitter of CO₂ and the 2nd plastic polluter into the ocean (Jupesta, Boer et al. 2011, Jambeck, Geyer et al. 2015). As an effort to mitigate the Green House Gases, the government of Indonesia encouraged the manufacturing sector to mitigate CO₂ and GHG emissions in their properties. Several paint manufacturers have participated and implemented the program, such as a multinational company, PT. Mowilex Indonesia, with its parent company (Asia Coatings Enterprises Pte. Ltd. or ACE) that have just issued their sustainability program focusing on marine conservation, as well as reducing carbon emissions and plastic. Their products contain only trace of low VOCs (5 gram/litre), environmentally friendly, and discontinued their lead paint production since May 2019. Gradually, they committed to have lead-free paint on 2020. Another paint company, [PT. Indaco Warna Dunia](#), one of the lead-free paint domestic producers, also participated in a program to mitigate CO₂ emission since 2015.

In 2015, the Ministry of Industry issued a regulation to provide a guidance for Green Industry Standard under the [Minister of Industry Decree No. 51/M-IND/PER/6/2015](#) that have entered into force in 9 June 2015. Green Industry Standard is a reference for industry stakeholders in preparing consensus related to raw materials, supporting materials, energy, production processes, products, business management, waste management and/or other aspects that aim to realise a green industry.

The Minister of Industry stated that there are two strategies in realising a green industry in Indonesia. First, developing and support towards the greening of existing industries. Second, build new industries by applying the principles of green industry or creation of new green industries.

The greening of the existing industries towards green industries is carried out through various efforts including:

- (1) Plans for the application of 5 green industry standards, namely the textile industry, ceramic tiles, cement, steel, and pulp and paper;
- (2) Produce catalog of environmentally friendly raw materials for the textile, ceramic tile and food industries;
- (3) Development and dissemination of general and technical guidelines for energy conservation and CO₂ emissions reduction;
- (4) Development and dissemination of technical guidelines to conduct a feasibility study for the implementation of energy conservation and CO₂ emission reduction in manufacturing and industrial sector; and
- (5) Development and dissemination of guidelines for treating wastewater, hazardous and toxic substances (*Bahan Berbahaya dan Beracun* or B3).

Furthermore, (6) the development of the guide to cleaner production; and (7) mechanical restructuring program for the sugar industry, textile industry and textile products as well as the leather and footwear industry have been carried out since 2007; and (8) give incentives in a form of Green Industry awards already conducted since 2010. In 2014 awards were given to 256 companies.

In 2018, two standards have been developed related to paint industry called RASIH (*Rancangan Akhir Standar Industri Hijau* or Final Draft of Green Industry Standards) (BPPI 2019). The relevant RASIH for paint and ink industry that have been developed are:

- RASIH for water-base paint industries
- RASIH for organic solvent-base paint industries

Lead, specifically PbO₂ is used for primary paint for rust inhibitor because of its low cost and durability from weather fluctuation. Lead-octoate or naphtenate (metallic soap), is used for drying agent in alkyd-based resin paint. In yellow, orange, green brown, red, beige, pink, coloured paint, lead is used as colouring agent for its cost and durability.

1.3 Stakeholders mapping

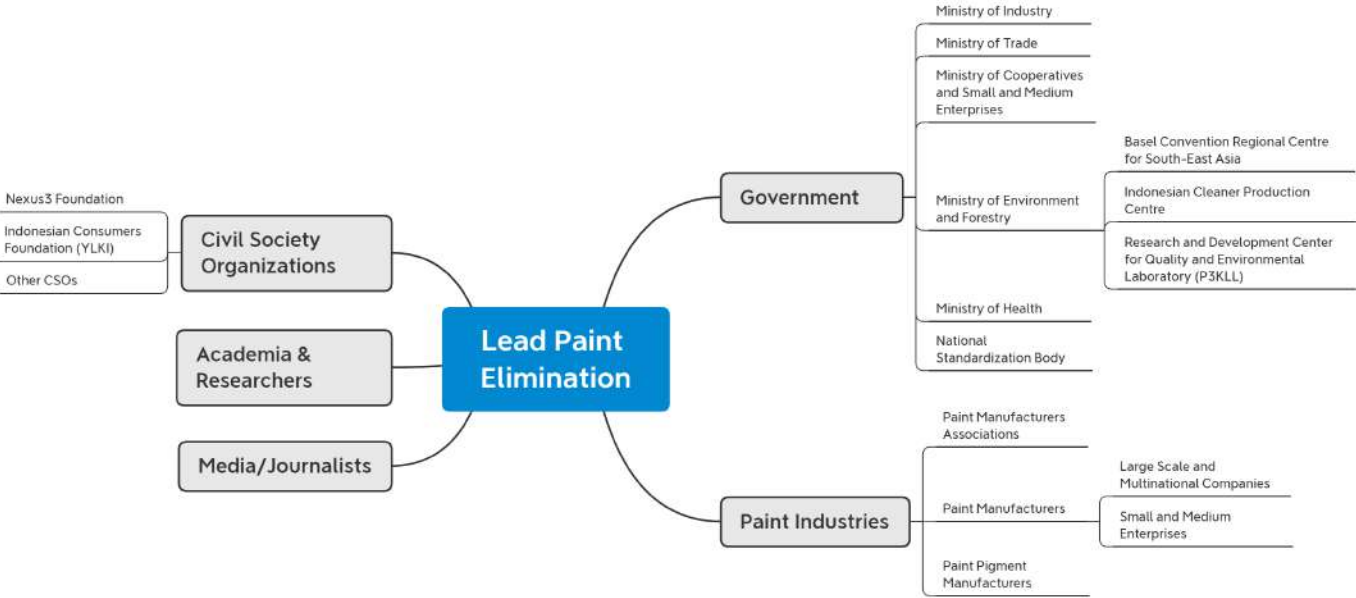


Fig. 6. Stakeholders mapping of Indonesia’s lead paint project.

A simple diagram that show the Indonesian lead paint elimination stakeholders is shown in Figure 6 in the following page.

1.4 Paint industry organisations

In Indonesia there are two national associations of paint industry:

[APCI](#) (*Asosiasi Produsen Cat Indonesia* or Indonesia Paint Manufacturers Association). APCI has 31 members, mostly paint manufacturers with legal licences, medium to large size companies including multi-national corporations. The head of APCI is [Kris Rianto Adidarma](#), CEO of [PT Propan Raya](#).

The formation of paint manufacturers association of Indonesia has been pioneered since 1982 which was then pioneered by PT Mega Eltra/Cat Utama, known as PT Sigma Utama, with Chairman Mr. Dedi Krisna. The association was registered under the name of the Indonesian Cat Industry Association or *Gabungan Pengusaha Industri Cat Indonesia* (GPICI) which in English is called the Indonesian Paint Manufacture Association (IPMA).

On January 11, 2005 during the leadership of Mr. Adiwan Johanli (from PT International Paint), the association was renamed as the Indonesian Paint Manufacturers Association, abbreviated as APCI with Notarial Deed dated August 18, 2005.

With the termination of Mr. Adiwan's assignment at PT International Paint, there was a leadership vacuum, until the next General Meeting of APCI Members as General Chair was agreed to appointed Mr. Mara Amikal from PT Sigma Utama, with a change in Notarial Deed dated February 28, 2013.

In 2017, Mr. Mara Amikal resigned from PT Sigma Utama, there was a leadership vacuum in APCI and it was not until around February 2018 that an agreement was made to fill the vacancy. The Chair was asked by Mr. Judirzal, from Abadi Coatings, to become a 'caretaker'.

1.5 Market leaders and SMEs paint industry

The top five paint manufacturers in Indonesia are as follow:²

- PT ICI Paints Indonesia (AkzoNobel Decorative Paints Indonesia);
- Nippon Paint Holdings Co (NIPSEA Paints and Chemicals) that sells the Vinilex and other premium brands;
- PT Propan Raya Industrial Coating Chemicals;
- PT Avia Avian Tbk; and
- PT Asian Paint Indonesia.

Paint industries are spread out around 7 provinces in Indonesia, there are: Banten, DKI Jakarta, West Java, Central Java, East Java, Riau Islands, and North Sumatera. Table 1 below shows the details:

Based on the size, companies are classified into three categories, which are multinational manufacturing company, domestic manufacturing company, and small-medium enterprises with details as follows:

- PMA (Penanaman Modal Asing / Foreign Investment Company): 34 companies
- PMDN (Perusahaan Manufaktur Dalam Negeri / Domestic Manufacturing Company): 92 companies
- UKM (Usaha Kecil–Menengah / Small–Medium Enterprises): 23 companies

2. Regulatory framework related to lead paint

Paint industries is regulated under the Ministry of Industry, Directorate of Directorate General of Chemical, Pharmacy, and Textile Industries, Directorate of Downstream Chemical and Pharmacy Industries. Despite having been targeted to have mandatory national standard since 2015, there are no mandatory policy for paint industry on lead concentrations in paint.

The voluntary national standards are listed as follows:

- SNI 8011-2014 : Organic Solvent-based Decorative Paint (sets a maximum lead content of 600 ppm for paint manufactured in Indonesia, Voluntary Standard)
- SNI 0465-2014: Paint Sampling Protocol

- SNI 3564-2014: Emulsion Wall Paint
- SNI 8069-2014: Test Protocol for Trace Concentration of Lead, Cadmium, and Cobalt in Paint using Atomic Absorber Spectrophotometer
- SNI ISO 8124-3:2010: Toy Safety - Part 3: Specification for migration of certain elements
- SNI 7188.6: 2010 on Ecolabel Criteria: Part 6 - Wall Paint Product category (Voluntary Allowable content: Pb < 90 mg/kg)
- SNI 3564: 2009 on Emulsion Wall Paint (Voluntary Heavy metals (Pb, Cu, Hg, Cd, Cr6+) < 90 ppm)
- SNI 2407:2008 on Code of conduct for wood painting for houses and buildings (not containing mercury and lead., mandatory for buildings)
- SNI 06-3685.1-2000 on Specification for red lead ready-mixed paint (mandatory for buildings)
