Aims for the Workshop

- To **identify areas of synergy** between the beyond 2020 process for chemicals and waste and other key areas, such as biodiversity, climate change & health.

- Is there potential to have indicators in common with other processes?
- What key messages would you like to see presented to IP3?

- The current SAICM indicators are an important input, but we will think more widely
