To share the Co-Chairs expectations for the resumed fourth meeting of the Intersessional Process considering the Strategic Approach and sound management of chemicals and waste beyond 2020 (IP4) meeting with SAICM Stakeholders, with a particular focus on possible solutions to the gaps in the text, how completeness and coherence could be ensured throughout the text as well as listening to participants expectations on the way to ICCM5.

An overview presentation by the IP Co-Chairs to be followed by a Q&A session.

All SAICM stakeholders are invited to attend.

Expected outcome:

Participants are briefed on the IP Co-Chairs vision of how the gaps in the single consolidated document [SAICM/IP.4/10](#) could be addressed and how the overall completeness and coherence of the document could be achieved.

Participants are familiarized with the scope of a comprehensive set of recommendations mandated from the Beyond 2020 intersessional process to be forwarded to ICCM5 for consideration.

Participants have a thorough understanding of the proposed structure and flow of the resumed IP4 meeting, including which documents are the basis of discussions at IP4; and how the in-session work at the resumed IP4 will be organized.
