## WORK SINCE IP4.1

- The IP Co-Chairs launched a stakeholder consultation process in Nov – Dec 2022 to inform and guide the organisation of work on the single consolidated document and other key issues to be considered in preparation for the resumed IP4 meeting.
- Submissions received provided a strong recommendation that the focus of the work at the resumed IP4 meeting should be on finalising the single consolidated document for consideration by ICCM5 in Bonn, Germany, from 25 to 29 September 2023.

## WORK SINCE IP4.1

- **Gaps** in the single consolidated text and **enhancements or improvements** could be made, for instance in relation to introductory text, targets, taking stock of progress, financing and capacity building.
- **Further work** is needed to adequately **strengthen and enhance sectoral and multistakeholder engagement and ownership** under the new instrument/framework.
- **Further discussion** is needed on placement of some text of the new instrument/framework as well as considering some parts of the text as **static and dynamic**.
- A **common view** from stakeholders over the need to **start discussing other recommendations for consideration by ICCM5**, for instance on the **name and adoption of the new instrument/framework**, and we will undertake efforts to reflect this need in the work schedule at the resumed IP4 meeting.

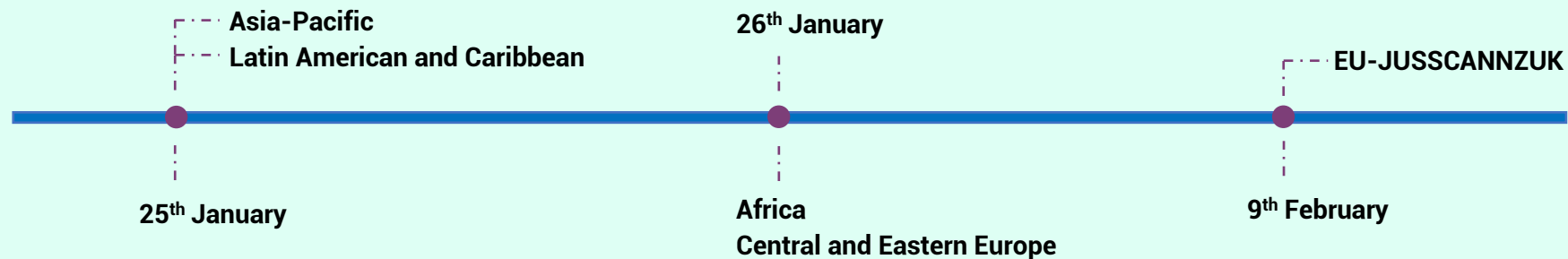

**DISCUSS** the scope of a comprehensive set of IP recommendations and agree on proposals for addressing these



**CLEAR AND SIMPLE** language used to communicate our work

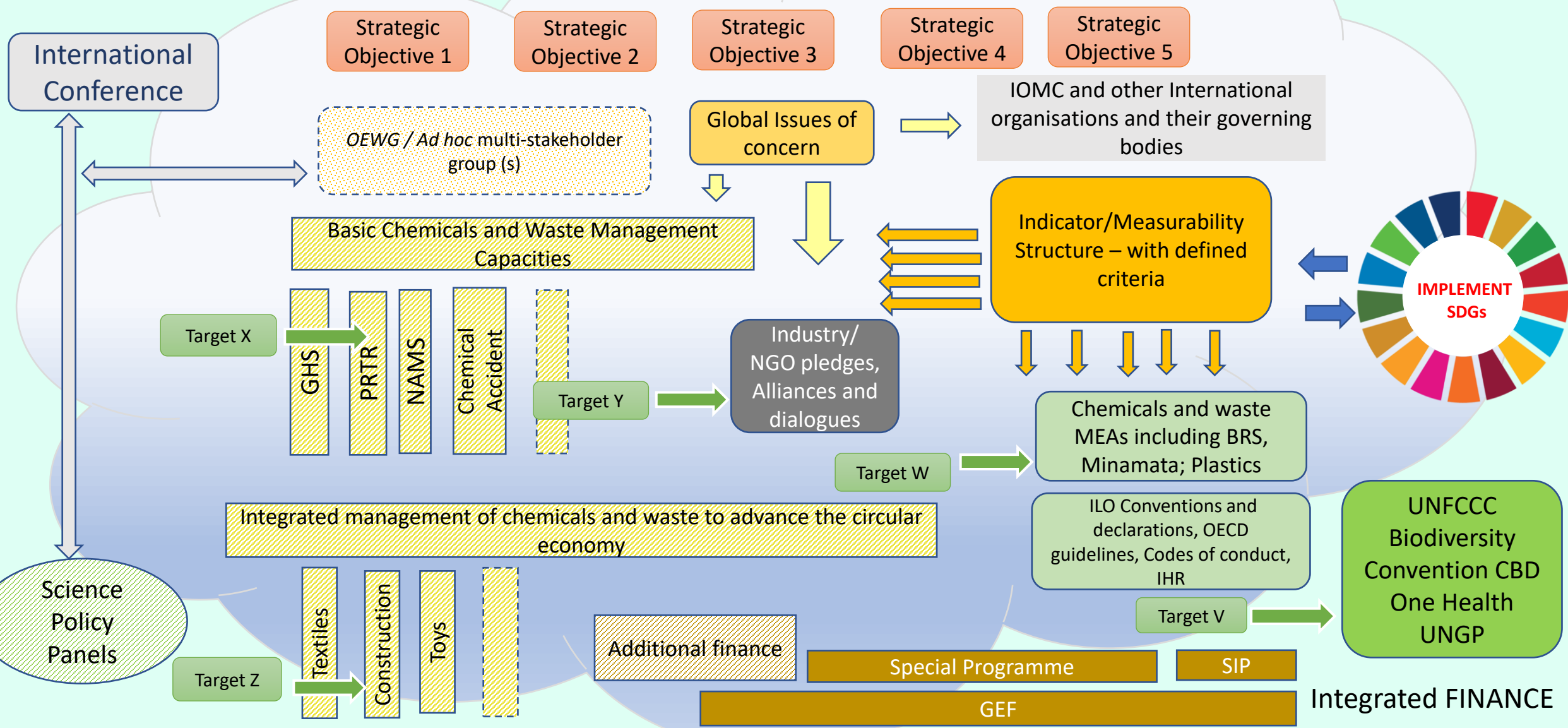

-  **FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS** to consider innovative financing approaches and operationalize the three pillars of the integrated approach to financing
-  **REVISE AND EDIT** the current text to create a better instrument



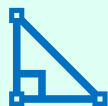


## SCENE SETTING FOR BEYOND 2020

Common understanding of the key work of the new instrument and how this will be achieved



A set of targets, both aspirational and measurable, that support the strategic objectives and vision

Robust means to support implementation of the framework



Progress in ensuring effective means to address financing implementation capacity
